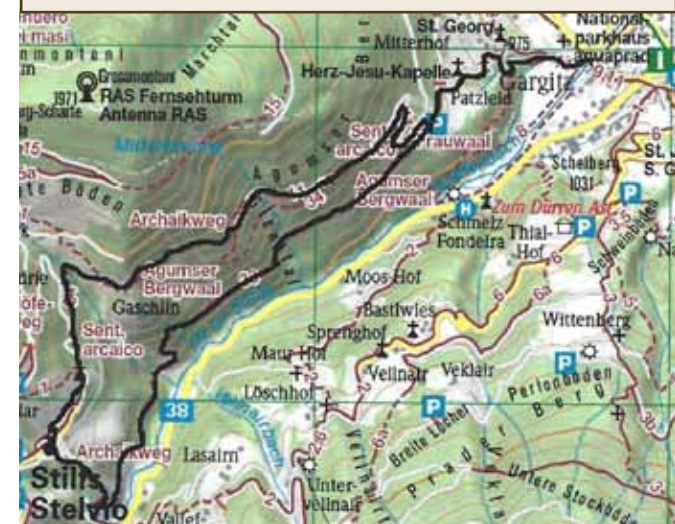


## Archaic path form Prato to Stelvio

The archaic path leads the hiker through parts of the transalpine historical route, passing the prehistoric village “Gaschlin” and leading up to the mountain village Stelvio. Starting from Prato, it initially goes towards Agumes and the upper bridge of the Rio Solda, where trail 11 begins. This passes through the village “Gargitz” to the “Patzleidhof” farm. From there the hike continues by choosing the paths of number 11 and 34 to Stelvio. The excursion is accompanied by a unique panoramic view of the mountains of the “Ortles Group”. Historical points are marked with information panels. We recommend a return via the “Bergwaal” of Agumes with marking 33.

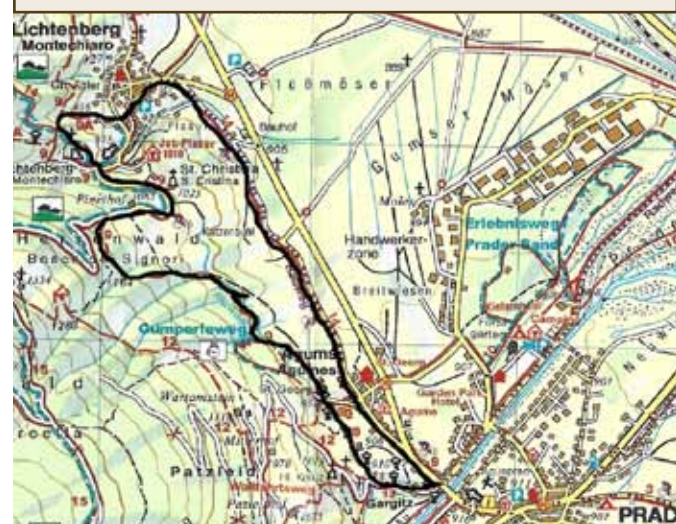

## Walk from Prato to Glorenza, passing the ruin of Montechiaro

The excursion starts at the bridge of the Rio Solda and initially leads with an ascent in the left direction, followed by a right turn to the “Höfeweg” of the marking 9, which leads from “Pinet” towards the ruin of Montechiaro. Once arrived there, the path continues and leads straight to Glorenza, passing the “Söles-Höfe” which are located towards San Martino and not far from the gates of the medieval town. On this excursion you can perfectly combine culture and walk. Glorenza, the smallest town in SouthTyrol has a special charm. We recommend a little break at the town’s “Tea Salon”, the museum of the famous artist Paul Flora or a small visit of Italy’s first Whiskey distillery, the “Puni” distillery. The return is possible on foot or by bus.

## Excursion on the Lottersteig

This excursion is a perfect hike for the whole family, crossing the woods above the village of Prato. Starting from the south exit of our campsite, the hike continues with the route to Cengles by following the marking number 7 up to the intersection with the path number 5. From there it goes on with a right turn, passing the farm “Stanlair”, the stream named “Nittbach and the two mills, up to the “Platzgenunhof” farm. Once arrived there, it leads on with the crossing of the “Tschirnbach” stream, followed by the descent through the so-called “Schweinböden”. Path 3 leads the hiker straight to path number 3, from where the return can be started by following the marking number 1.

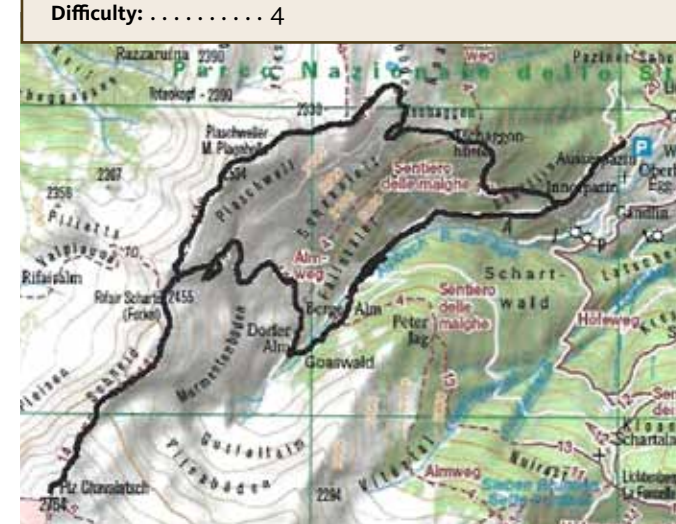

## High altitude excursion - Piz Chavalatsch

The hike promises an excellent panoramic view of the Ortles and Cevedale mountains, the Swiss mountains of the Engadin as well as the high and medium Val Venosta peaks. Starting from the parking lot “Pazzin Schoad” above Montechiaro, it continues along the path number 14 until the crossroads 14 B. By following this, the hiker will arrive both at the “Tschiggonhütte” and the intersection with the route 14A. From there it goes above the limit of arboreal vegetation and along the path up to the so-called “Rifairscharte”, where you change course by choosing trail number 14. This leads, never too much ascent, up to the top. It is recommended to return by following the route 14 through the mountain pasture of Montechiaro.

**Aim:** ..... Piz Chavalatsch (2764m)  
**Length:** ..... 15 km  
**Duration:** ..... 4 hours  
**Altitude:** ..... 1000 m  
**Difficulty:** ..... 4



## HIKING TIPS AROUND PRATO ALLO STELVIO



## Cultural trail to Cengles

This pleasant and cultural excursion has as its starting point the south exit of our campsite and leads from there directly to the village Cengles. At the beginning, the country lane leads to the Kneipp hydrotherapeutic treatment plant, from where it goes on with path number 7. Once there it continues by managing first about 80 m of altitude, followed by a flat way crossing fields and passing the small church of Santa Ottilia up to Cengles. We recommend a small stop at the inn of the castle “Tschenglsburg” before starting the return to the campsite, which leads through the apple fields.

**Aim:** ..... Tschengls (923m)  
**Length:** ..... 4 km  
**Duration:** ..... ca. 2,5 hours  
**Altitude:** ..... 200 m  
**Difficulty:** ..... 1



## Grove educational trail - Nittweg

Along the path of the Nittweg wood you can discover numerous native trees and shrubs. On the course of about 4 kilometers, they represent very different environments and living spaces. Findable are not just types, common for wet mountain valleys, but also typical plants of the dry “Monte del Sole”. Starting from the south exit of the campsite, it goes on – along the Nittweg and route number 7, straight to the Kneipp hydrotherapeutic treatment facility. From there the path leads with a slight ascent through a path of marking number 4, which contains descriptions regarding the living spaces of the plants. The forest trail with view leads on to the “Nauhof” and finally to the “Schweinböden”. Afterwards and by following path number 1 it goes back into the village, reaching first the so-called “Prader Schmelz” and then our campsite, by passing the dam of the Rio Solda.

**Length:** ..... 4 km  
**Duration:** ..... ca. 3,5 hours  
**Altitude:** ..... 245 m  
**Difficulty:** ..... 2



## Path of the Frauwaal - canal

This excursion leads, never going very steep, from Prato to the idyllic village of Montechiaro. Along the right bank of the Rio Solda it goes to the south end of Prato. After a short ascent, the tour continues relatively flat with trail number 9 up to the church of San Giorgio di Agumes. Once arrived there it continues with a slight ascent to the farms of “Pinet”. After a short descent will be reached the village Montechiaro or otherwise and with a little detour – the ruin of Castel Montechiaro. For the return is recommended the path number 1.

**Aim:** ..... Prad - Suldenbachbrücke (923m)

**Altitude:** ..... 200 m

## Path of the Bergwaal - canal

The hike through the mountain resort of Agumes to the Stelvio Bridge is a simple, sunny route along the Agumes mountain. Starting from Prato, it goes in direction of the village Agumes and the upper bridge of the Rio Solda, where trail number 11 has its beginning. This leads through the village “Gargitz” to the “Patzleidhof” farm. Once arrived there, it will be path number 33 which leads you along the disused irrigation canal up to the village of Ponte Stelvio. It is recommended to continue the hike by following trail number 34 - up to the mountain village Stelvio.

**Aim:** ..... Stilfserbrücke (1169m)  
**Length:** ..... 5,6 km  
**Duration:** ..... ca. 3 hours  
**Altitude:** ..... 350 m  
**Difficulty:** ..... 2
